### **BRC**

The BRC is designed for two kinds of people - those who have little or no experience, and those who want to improve their skills.

This course is comprised of 5 hours of classroom and 10 hours of riding instruction.

Whether you are in the classroom or riding on the range, certified RiderCoaches will use adult learning styles to insure a fun, dignity filled learning experience.

*This course is fully authorized by the Missouri Motorcycle Safety Program. Therefore, successfully completing this course permits you to waive the riding portion of the Missouri State test for motorcycle endorsement on your driver's license. Many insurance companies will recognize your successful completion with premium discounts.*
