The Salt River Expo is an Armed Forces weekend that features not only a salute to those who protect our way of life, but a celebration of the social benefits their service has afforded us. Being a family oriented event, there are certain guidelines we ask all participants to observe.

- *All exhibits in public view will be rated "G"
- * All exhibit spaces are FREE
- * Vendors are asked to accompany their registration with a 25.00 remittance to: Mark Twain Lake Chamber of Commerce (expo)
- * All animals shall be restrained and all handlers of animals shall ensure that public traffic areas remain free of animal waste.
- * Though we do have supervisory personnel, all exhibitors assume responsibility for the security of their exhibit
- * Period displays are asked to observe 9am to 9pm as a time frame that all aspects of their display conforms to the period represented.
- * If you do not plan to participate all three days please advise us of your schedule so we know what space is available if needed.
- * Participants are asked to arrive not earlier than Thursday and depart by Sunday evening
- * Electricity is available first to food vendors, then to exhibits requiring electricity to operate, and lastly to campers. (only one camper per exhibit.)
- * Water is available, but there are no camper waste hook-ups.
- * Fire pits are permitted, but must be restored.
