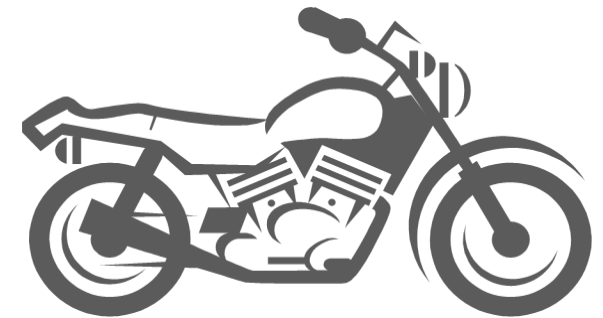

These proven programs add two elements to your riding:

1. **SAFETY** - Learn how to avoid and deal with unsafe situations.
2. **FUN** - Learn new skills while building confidence in your riding.

BRC

The BRC is designed for two kinds of people - those who have little or no experience, and those who want to improve their skills.

This course is comprised of 5 hours of classroom and 10 hours of riding instruction.

Whether you are in the classroom or riding on the range, certified Rider Coaches will use adult learning styles to insure a fun, dignity filled learning experience.

This course is fully authorized by the Missouri Motorcycle Safety Program. Therefore, successfully completing this course permits you to waive the riding portion of the Missouri State test for motorcycle endorsement on your driver's license. Many insurance companies will recognize your successful completion with premium discounts.

To insure your safety, the following items are mandatory to participate in these programs:

- **DOT Approved Full Face or 3/4 Helmet**
Loaners available
- **Long Sleeved Shirt or Jacket**
- **Sturdy Over the Ankle Boots**
- **Long Pants**
- **Eye Protection**
Eyeglasses or sunglasses accepted
- **Full Fingered Gloves**

Classes are held Rain or shine!

All participants must:

- Be at least 15 1/2 years old and have a driver's permit
- Have written permission of parent/guardian if under 18 years of age
- Show proof of motorcycle license and insurance when providing own motorcycle
- Sign a waiver of liability
- If needing class booklets mailed, please register at least two to three weeks prior to the class. This allows ample mailing time.
